***Training Agents who fail to respond to the wage survey by the indicated deadline of December 18<sup>th</sup> will be assessed a \$250 late fee and placed on a 3-month probation***

In compliance with Oregon Revised Statute 660.137(6), Area I Plumbers is conducting the annual wage survey to determine the average private sector wage among our training agents for Journeyman Plumbers.

The statute states: **“Employers who fail or refuse to provide their committee with the information shall be terminated as approved training agents.”**

The JATC is responsible for conducting the annual wage survey the results of which are used to determine apprentice wages. Your prompt reply is appreciated. All replies are confidential. The administrator tallies the wages and only the final average wage is made available to the JATC and the Bureau of Labor.
