Non-Union Plumbing Apprenticeship

Opening will be posted 30 days prior. Veterans qualify for automatic entry and may use GI benefits.

Job Description:

Journey worker plumbers repair and install water, gas, medical gas, and other piping systems. These systems can be in homes, businesses, commercial areas, and factories. They install toilets, showers, appliances, water heaters, repair/maintain septic systems, etc. They also clean drains, remove obstructions, repair, and replace broken pipes or other fixtures.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. High school graduation or a general education development (GED) certificate.
- 2.Completion of one year of high school algebra or equivalent post high school algebra course(s) with a passing grade. ('D' or better for graded classes or 'Pass" for non-graded classes) OR must present current math placement results from a community college facility indicating a placement of math 60 or above.
- 3. Must be 18 years of age or older.

Term of Apprenticeship:

A minimum of 7,700 (4 years) of on-the-job training is required for completion of apprenticeship. Related training classes held at Clackamas Community College; two evenings per week/3 terms per year. Total of 144 hours per year of apprenticeship.

WAGES:

The average journeyman plumber wage for the committee is \$46.95 per hour effective February 1, 2024. A beginning apprentice earns \$21.13 per hour (45% of journey worker wage). Wages increase as the apprentice gains onthe-job hours and classroom training.



Program is registered with the state of Oregon Women and minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
